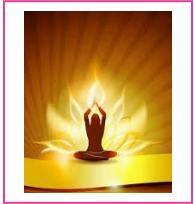

Cost: \$20 for all 10 sessions. Pay at the CLV Front Desk using your Watcard



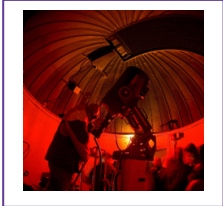
