Applications are evaluated on a rolling basis.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

- Minimum grade: B+ (3.3 out of 4.0 GPA, or 78%) in the final year of a 4-year program
- Prerequisite courses: Micro, macro, calculus, linear algebra, econometrics/statistics (applicants who have not take these courses may be admitted on a conditional basis)
- Standardized tests: Applicants who do not have a degree from a Canadian university must submit an official GRE® General Test score or GMAT® score. Applicants who have graduated from a university where the language of instruction is not English must provide TOEFL® or IELTS™ scores
- Two academic references
- Statement of interest
- Resumé (one page)
- Video interview
- \$150 application fee
